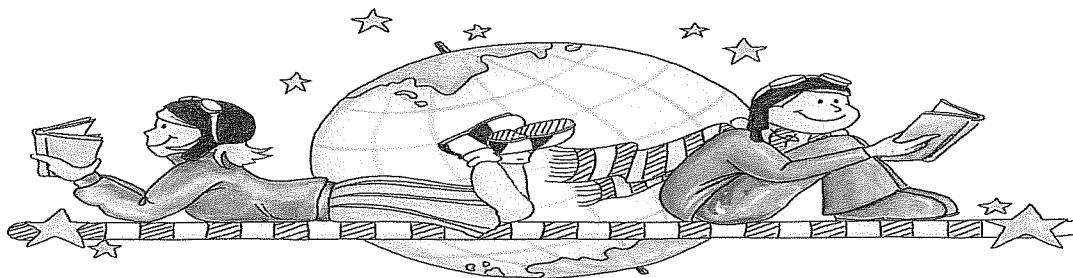

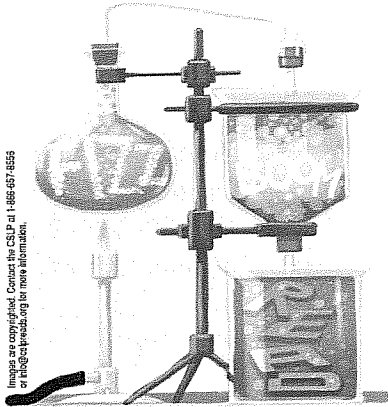

SUMMER READING PROGRAM

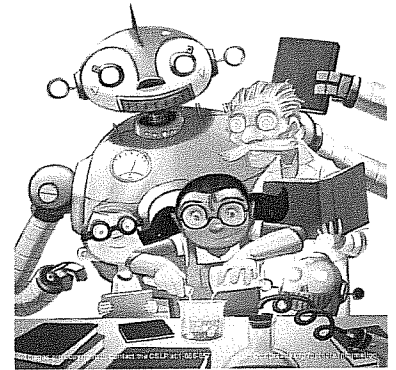
