One day trash delay due to Memorial Day

The upcoming Memorial Day holiday does impact solid waste collection services provided to all 34 MMWA member communities.

There will be no trash, recycling, or yard waste collection provided on Monday, May 29. The MMWA office will also be closed in observance of the holiday.

With the holiday falling on a Monday, collection services will be delayed one day for every community the week of Memorial Day, May 29. Residents should prepare and set out materials one day later than they normally do during the holiday week. For example, if your normal collection day is Monday, you should put your materials to the curb on Tuesday.

Mosquito Abatement Tire Drives set

The Saginaw County Mosquito Abatement Commission has announced its June tire drive locations and details. These collections are open to Saginaw County residents (not businesses) and will accept up to ten tires per property, per year. Rims must be removed from tires, and only tires from cars, trucks, motorcycles, and bikes will be accepted. SCMAC does not accept semi, tractor, or heavy equipment tires. There will be two week-long tire drives in 2017, one series from June 19-23 and one from July 17-21, all from 8 am to 2:30 pm. June dates are:
