Call to Order of Meeting:

Vice-Chair Mike Marr called the August 20th, 2024, Regular Meeting of the Birch Run Township Planning Commission (PC) to order at 19:00 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members Present:

New Business:

Compatible Renewable Energy Ordinance (CREO):

Discussion included:

- Removing the listed Energy Storage Definition from the CREO.
- Making the Small-Scale Solar & Wind more uniform (less than, more than 50').
- Reconciling Section 3 with Section 4 and making terminology the same (Facility over Farm).

Event Barn Ordinance:

Currently, there is no minimum lot size in the Ordinance. Draft ordinance provided with added language for the 5+ acre and 200' buffer to nearby occupied dwellings requirements. Determined it was ready for the public hearing.

Old Business:

Short-Term Rentals (STR) Ordinance:

The PC continued its discussion on STR's. They began discussing Fire-safety regulations but determined that would all be included in applicable fire/building codes already, especially for +2,000 square foot homes which would be required to put in a fire suppression system. Disallowing the use of fireworks on the premises of STR's was added, as well as a 300' buffer from STR to STR. The previous requirement of copies of insurance being provided was struck – an affidavit stating the applicant has the insurance replaced it.

Parking in Setbacks:

Per previous discussions, a draft copy of the ordinance was presented, showing the additions to Table 9-4 by adding language to #9 and adding footnote #10.

<u>Public Comment:</u> 19:26 – 19:45 Public Comment was held. Jorge Garcia asked questions of the Planning Commission.
